Occasionally, every leader gets called on to address a group out of courtesy. These are the moments that you can stand out from the average leader. There are three basic elements you need to remember.

First, have a positive message. Don't just thank the group for their hospitality and your warm reception. Impart some exciting new information, share your uplifting vision for the organization, or inspire the audience to reach for their full potential. No matter what, end your message in an uplifting and positive fashion.

Second, let your excitement show. Be thrilled to have the opportunity to share your positive message and you will stand out from the crowd. Afterall, there will be times that the presiding officer may forget to call upon you. When you have the opportunity to share your message, be sure to smile and be enthused.

Third, be brief. Know that in courtesy situations, that less is more. Share your message, thank the group, and leave them wanting more. Learn to keep your comments lean, and people will not groan in dreaded anticipation when you are called upon.

Always be ready with your short positive and exciting message and if you are not called upon, smile and be ready for the next time.

Membership recruitment should be a team activity
