Stand Up

How many meetings have you attended when most of those who speak during the meeting remain seated? Be a leader, and when you speak at your meeting, stand up. There are several

reasons to simply stand up when you share your opinion or perform your duties during the meeting.

When you stand, it draws the attention of the audience to you, and tends to stop any conversations that may be going on. Standing gives you the opportunity to be the center of attention while you speak.

Psychologically, standing gives you an advantage in a seated group. You command attention before you even open your mouth. Every good speaker uses simple techniques like standing to get and keep the attention of their audience.

You will be more easily heard when you speak while standing. Your voice carries better when it is above your audience and standing lets you be a little louder than when you are seated. Increase the chance that your message or discussion will be understood by standing.

If your organization has developed the bad habit of talking while seated, start standing when you speak and set a positive example.
